- Aproximately 25 newborns per year were born at DCH the past few years.
- Aproximately one-half of those newborns were children of Davis County residents.
- Expecting Mothers may still have their ultrasounds and lab screenings performed close to home at Davis County Hospital.



- Davis County Hospital Physicians will continue to offer care to infants.
- Parents can receive Obstetrics services nearby at Van Buren County Hospital, Mercy Medical Center-Centerville, or Ottumwa Regional Health Center.
